- We have issued the report for the internal audit of the Development Department. The department is funded through an annual budgetary appropriation of the County's General Fund (001.690) including Administrative Adjudication (001.690.691), Economic Development Fund (400.690), Quality of Kane Grants Fund (407.690), and Growing for Kane fund (435.690). Additional funding for special projects go through an annual internal application and process administered and funded by Riverboat Grant funds.
