Updates from the Auditor's Office

- Risk Assessment Initiative Over the next few months, all Kane County offices and departments
 will be asked to participate in updating the County Auditor's risk assessment processes. The
 revised questionnaire should be finalized over the next several weeks, and should be circulated to
 stakeholders shortly thereafter. It will take some time to conduct the necessary interviews and
 compile the results, but the goal is to have a current profile developed prior to the end of the fiscal
 year in order to assist in the development of our Internal Audit schedule for fiscal year 2019 and
 beyond.
- <u>Transition Audits</u> It has become necessary to modify the internal audit schedule for fiscal 2018 to
 perform two transition audits that were not in the original plan. Preliminary fieldwork has begun for
 both the KaneComm and Office of Emergency Management transition audits. We are grateful for
 the cooperation shown by outgoing Directors Farris and Bryant.
- <u>Aurora Election Commission</u> Pending the Court's determination of which AEC assets and liabilities
 will be transferred to Kane County as part of the dissolution process, it may be necessary for the
 County Auditor to perform an attestation similar in function to a transition audit. Preliminary
 meetings and conversations have been held between the County Clerk and the County Auditor to
 determine what, if any, services will be required.
- Due to a staffing issue in the Auditor's office, it has become necessary to re-assign the internal audit of the County Board. As a result, that project has been delayed indefinitely.

Accounts Payable Claims Paid Report

The <u>Accounts Payable Claims Paid Report for April 2018</u> shows that 2,576 invoices were processed which resulted in payments of \$7,807,686.89.
